**INFORMATION DISTRIBUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH
ART. 13 OF ITALIAN LEGISLATIVE DECREE NO. 196/2003***

Dear Sir or Madam:

In accordance with Art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (henceforth T.U.), ("Code for the Protection of Personal Data"), the law regulating the protection of persons and bodies with respect to the treatment of personal data, such treatment must be inspired by principles of fairness, lawfulness and transparency, and the protection of your privacy and your rights. With respect to the treatment of personal data, which the Association shall collect, we inform you of the following:

1. PURPOSE OF DATA TREATMENT

Treatment is allowed solely in pursuit of the Purposes of the Association, within the limits prescribed by law, and in compliance with the provisions of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003.

2. METHODS OF DATA TREATMENT

- a. Treatment shall be effected by actions or complexes of actions as indicated in Art. 4, Sec. 1, Sub. A T.U.: collection, registration, organisation, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnecting, blocking, sharing, deletion and data distribution.
- b. Actions may be effected with or without the use of electronic or automated equipment.
- c. Treatment shall be effected by the holder and/or officers responsible for treatment.

3. SUPPLY OF DATA

Supply of personal data is strictly necessary for the realisation of the ends provided for by Point 1.

4. REFUSAL TO SUPPLY DATA

Should the interested party refuse to supply its personal data, it shall be impossible to realise, as indicated in Point 3, the ends provided for by Point 1.

5. SHARING OF DATA

Personal data shall be available to the officers responsible for treatment, and may be shared, for the ends provided for by Point 1, with external agents and, generally, with other bodies, as may be required for the realisation of the ends provided for by Point 1.

6. DISSEMINATION OF DATA

Personal data shall not be disseminated.

7. TRANSFER OF DATA ABROAD

Personal data may be transferred abroad, to countries within or without the European Union, within the limits of the ends provided for by Point 1.

8. RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

Art. 7 T.U. endows the interested party with certain rights, including that of obtaining from the holder confirmation of the existence or non-existence of its personal data, and the right to receive it for review in an intelligible manner. The interested party reserves the right to know the origin of the data, the ends and methods relative to its treatment, the reasoning applied during its treatment, and the personal data of its holder and of all bodies to which it has been disseminated. Furthermore, the interested party reserves the right to update, correct, complete, delete and anonymise its data, or prohibit its use when it has not been treated lawfully. The interested party reserves the right to oppose, for legitimate reasons, the treatment of its data.

9. OFFICER RESPONSIBLE FOR TREATMENT

The holder is the "Associazione Italiana di Scienza e Tecnologia delle Macromolecole" - AIM, headquartered in Bologna.

The officer responsible for treatment is the Administrative Secretary.
